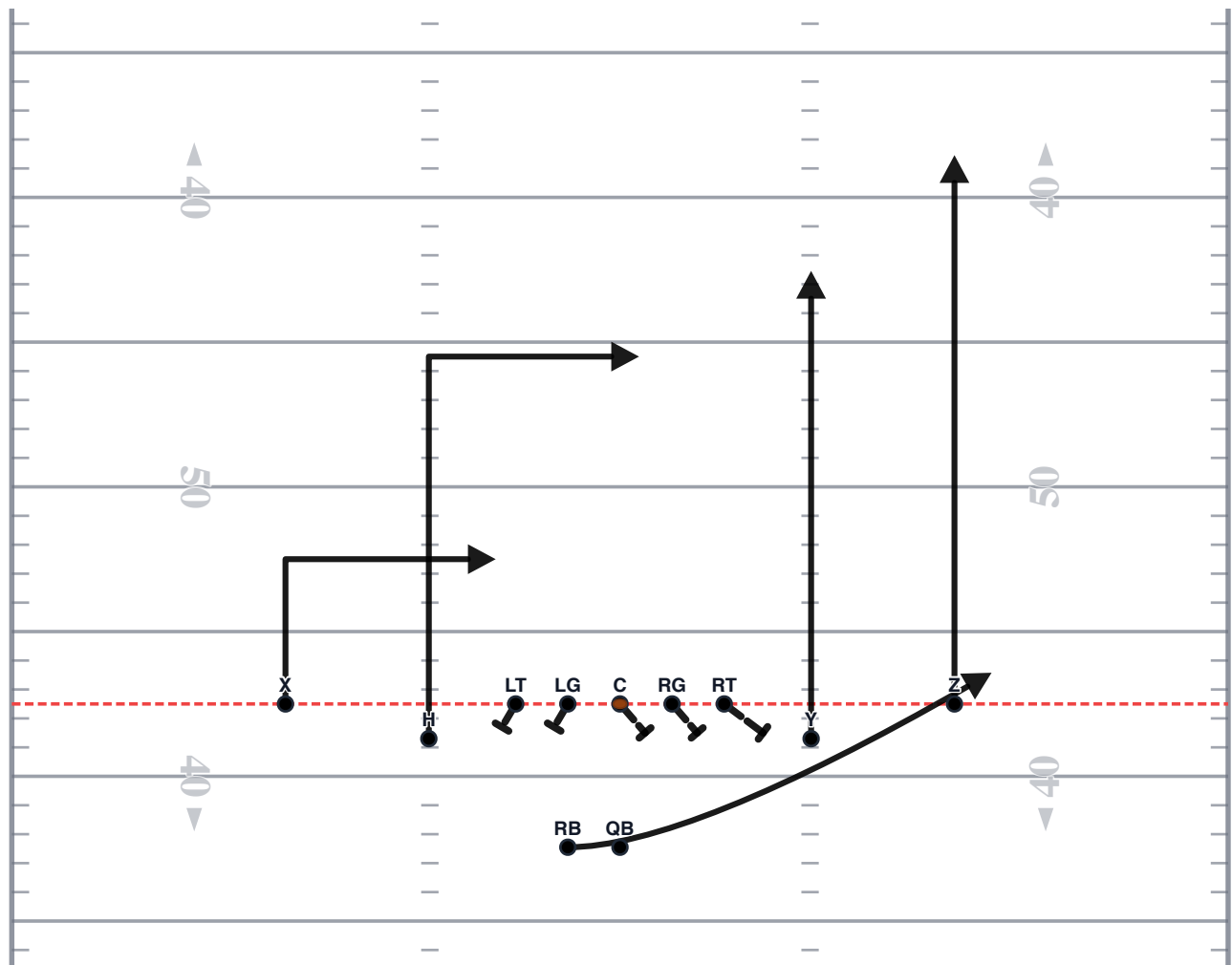


Gun Doubles Rt Levels

CONCEPT		
Two-man Levels: alert the backside seam, then read the underneath defender from the five-yard in to the twelve-yard dig. Maintain five-man half-slide protection and a backfield outlet.		
ASSIGNMENTS		
Pos	Assignment	Key Points
LT	Block path: Man edge protection	Protection: half slide right. Confirm the point and slide/man responsibilities before the snap; preserve the pocket at the quarterback's set point.
LG	Block path: Man gap protection	Protection: half slide right. Confirm the point and slide/man responsibilities before the snap; preserve the pocket at the quarterback's set point.
C	Block path: Slide right pass set	Protection: half slide right. Confirm the point and slide/man responsibilities before the snap; preserve the pocket at the quarterback's set point.
RG	Block path: Slide right pass set	Protection: half slide right. Confirm the point and slide/man responsibilities before the snap; preserve the pocket at the quarterback's set point.
RT	Block path: Slide right pass set	Protection: half slide right. Confirm the point and slide/man responsibilities before the snap; preserve the pocket at the quarterback's set point.
QB	3-step drop	Confirm the front, coverage shell and protection or exchange call before the snap. Keep the cadence and initial action consistent with the companion plays.
RB	Route: Flat	Match your footwork to the drawn mesh and aiming point; secure possession before accelerating and keep the ball away from the pursuit side.
X	Route: Five-yard in	Keep the split, release and stem consistent with the drawn concept. Attack the defender's leverage without changing the route landmark or crowding the adjacent route.
H	Route: Twelve-yard dig	Keep the split, release and stem consistent with the drawn concept. Attack the defender's leverage without changing the route landmark or crowding the adjacent route.
Y	Route: Backside seam alert	Keep the split, release and stem consistent with the drawn concept. Attack the defender's leverage without changing the route landmark or crowding the adjacent route.
Z	Route: Backside clear-out	Keep the split, release and stem consistent with the drawn concept. Attack the defender's leverage without changing the route landmark or crowding the adjacent route.
